What is good attendance?

- Excellent attendance • 98% attendance = 4 days of absence across the school year National attendance target 96% = 7 days of absence across the school year • 95% attendance = 10 days of absence across the school year
 - Below expectations improvement required
 - 92% attendance = 15 days of absence across the school year
 - Poor attendance absence is likely to impact on learning
 - 90% attendance = 19 days of absence across the school year
 - Persistent or severe absence learning and progress will suffer
 - Possible referral to external agencies

Why does attendance matter?

- > You fall behind in work and lessons.
- > You have lower motivation to be here at all.
- Your enjoyment of learning is less.
- You have less chance of achieving GCSEs.
- You're more likely to show poor behaviour
- > You miss out on the social life of school and extra curricular opportunities and experiences.
- It effects your ability to have or keep friendships
